# Requirements for Participation

---

**LEGA is free to join and is open to government, law enforcement and NGO entities that:**

- Commit to sending at least three staff members through the CFE certification process within the first two years of joining LEGA.
- Include the CFE credential in the agency's hiring practices and recruiting information.
- Consider the CFE credential as an important and positive factor during personnel reviews. How this is accomplished is left to the sole discretion of the agency.
- Provide the ACFE with a written letter of acknowledgement of the CFE credential.
